## **CONNECTION SETTING**

Adjust settings for connection to other devices.

To access connection settings, press **MENU/OK**, select the **I** (SET UP) tab, and choose **CONNECTION SETTING**.



#### WIRELESS SETTINGS

Adjust settings for connection to wireless networks.

Option	Description
GENERAL SETTINGS	Choose a name ( <b>NAME</b> ) to identify the camera on the wireless network (the camera is assigned a unique name by default) or select <b>RESET WIRELESS SETTINGS</b> to restore default settings.
RESIZE IMAGE FOR Smartphone 🖾	Choose <b>ON</b> (the default setting, recommended in most circumstances) to resize larger images to <b>SM</b> for upload to smartphones, <b>OFF</b> to upload images at their original size. Resizing applies only to the copy uploaded to the smartphone; the original is not affected.
ACCESS POINT SETTINGS	<ul> <li>SIMPLE SETUP: Connect to an access point using simple settings.</li> <li>MANUAL SETUP: Manually adjust settings for connection to a wireless network. Choose the network from a list (SE-LECT FROM NETWORK LIST) or enter the name manually (ENTER SSID).</li> </ul>
IP ADDRESS	<ul> <li>AUTO: The IP address is assigned automatically.</li> <li>MANUAL: Assign an IP address manually. Manually choose the IP address (IP ADDRESS), network mask (NETMASK), and gateway address (GATEWAY ADDRESS).</li> </ul>

#### The Printer Name (SSID) and Password-

The printer name (SSID) can be found on the bottom of the printer; the default password is "1111". If you have already chosen a different password to print from a smartphone, enter that password instead.

- Tethered shooting is available with software such as HS-V5 (available separately) or FUJIFILM X Acquire (available for free download from the FUJIFILM website) or when the FUJIFILM Tether Shooting Plug-in PRO or Tether Shooting Plug-in (both available separately) is used with Adobe® Photoshop® Lightroom®.
